



PRESCO ZERO BURNING POLICY

As part of its environmental responsibility as well as its commitment to the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil certification and to reducing its greenhouse gas emissions Presco's plantations follow a strict zero burning policy.

Fire is not used in any of Presco's operations, including for land-clearing in the case of new planting, replanting or any other development. All land-clearing activities are carried out mechanically and felled vegetation is shredded for nutrient recycling.

Presco does not allow farming within its estates as local farmers use fire as a means of land preparation.

Presco employees are sensitized on the zero-burning policy and fire-surveillance teams are trained to monitor, react to, control and manage involuntary fire outbreaks in the plantations, particularly during the dry season when fire risks are at their highest.

Furthermore, our waste management strategy focuses on reducing, reusing and recycling rather than burning waste.

Presco management is responsible for the effective implementation of this policy.

This policy shall be reviewed periodically to ensure that it remains relevant to company operations and activities.
