

PRESCO WILDLIFE PROTECTION POLICY

This Policy outlines Presco commitment to conserve wild life and nature, ensuring that its plantation co-exists with conservation by the sustainable utilization of men, material and land to ensure maintenance of biodiversity and forest cover. Presco shall use the following strategies to achieve its wildlife protection aim:

- Establishment of buffer zone around conservation areas during land preparation for its plantation development.
- Involving a broader section of the host community in wildlife conservation through education, particularly those around the conservation area.
- Educating the workforce on wildlife conservation.
- Prohibition of farming, logging, poaching and hunting within the conservation area and further discipline of members of workforce and prosecution of members of the public who deviate from this policy.
- Conservation of the diversity and integrity of plants and animals within the natural ecosystem.
- Periodic survey of ecological population to ensure adequate monitoring of fauna and flora status.
- Mitigate human wildlife conflicts and enhance positive attitude towards conservation of wildlife resources.
- Management of wildlife resources outside conservation areas by redirecting animals found within the plantation area back to the conservation area.
- Establish and maintain major wildlife corridor within its planation.
- Planned patrol by Eco guards to ensure safety and security in wildlife conservation areas.

The coordination and implementation of this policy will be supervised by the HSE/Agric/Security Departments. This policy will be reviewed periodically and revised as necessary in the light of changing conditions and the findings of surveys/studies conducted.
